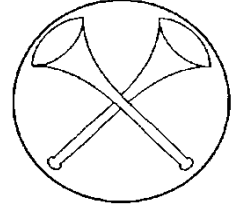

1: Agrippa Morris - New Badge (*Fieldless*) a caltrop sable

permission to conflict obtained Cynehild Cynesigesdohtor and Clare Elena de Montfort their Barony Eskalya, Per chevron sable and Or, a caltrop sable

Considering the tinctureless badge of Eleanor Leonard (reg. July 1982 via Atlantia), (Tinctureless) A mullet of four points distilling a goutte. One DC for any changes to tincture whatsoever (including the fieldlessness). Eleanor has granted permission to conflict when the charge is of a divided tincture, but that doesn't apply here. No difference for the distilled gout, so the only question is the difference, if any, between a caltrop and a mullet of four points.

Their Excellencies Cynehild and Clare are the baronesses of Eskalya. The permission to conflict is appropriately worded, dated, and signed with their legal signatures. for the goutte making this clear from Eleanor Leonard's badge.

2: Diana Delamontaigne - New Name & New Device *Azure, a tyger rampant argent between three decrescents Or*

3: Godfrey filius Eduinus - New Name & New Device *Argent, a patriarchial cross sable in chief two millets of eight points gules.*

Godfrey -- an English masculine given name, dated 1273, found in Withycombe, 3rd ed., p. 136.

filius -- latin for son (of)

Eduinus -- the father's given name, latinized, to complete the patronymic. Eduinus is found in Withycombe, 3rd ed., p. 95, under Edwin. Eduinus is dated 1200-19.

In the May 2011 Cover Letter, Pelican wrote "These names can be registered ... in mixes of vernacular and Latinized forms. That's because we can find records for most places that have completely Latinized forms, mostly vernacular forms, or some mix (most commonly Latinized given names and vernacular bynames, but other mixes are found too)."

From the registration from Serpent's Eye, Order of, Sept 2014 LoAR

The pattern of Order of the Serpent's X, where X is a body part, is grandfathered to the barony. The use of the modern Serpent's instead of Serpents is also grandfathered.

Submitter desires a masculine name.

No major changes.

Meaning (stone-bear) most important.

Originally submitted as Ingvarr Hallbjorn with the requested meaning of "stone-bear" After consultation with the submitter he agreed to the change of the surname to the patronymic. He also is aware that nothing in this name means stone-bear and is fine with that.

Ingvarr is found as a masculine given name found in GB pg 12

Ingvar, 1 n" is found in familysearch records as a masculine given name dated to 1600's in Sweden

Hallbjorn (actually "Hallbjørn") is found in GB pg 10 as a male given name with 6 examples. The submitter prefers the form without the o-ogonek.

He prefers Hallbjornsson but will accept Hallbiarnarsson if required

Later period examples of *bjornsson" are found in familysearch records all also in Sweden.

Ávaldr is a masculine name found on p. 8 in GB and the feminine patronymic is formed as stated in GB
